SZŐNYI KATALIN: Mechanization of literary information at the SZÁMOK (International Computer Education and Information Centre). – The ISIS programme package for a complex library mechanization, developed in 1972 by the International Labour Office (ILO) in Geneva, was taken over in 1976 by the SZÁMOK. Present article describes the antecedents and reasons of changing over to computer, the selection of the programme package, further on, the preparations for the installation of the ISIS system; the changes, becoming due to the different operating environment; the ISIS programme package system is characterized, in the first place, from the input and output sides; the literary on-line retrieval system, called BABILON and developed in this country, is presented; evidences are analysed and future plans outlined. PAPP ISTVÁN: The activity of the Centre for Library Science and Methodology in 1980 and between the years 1976–1980. – The article arranges in groups the results according to two aspects: 1. by the organizational order of the Centre it presents the activities performed in 1980 in the following departments: network development, library technology, reading research, stock building, library training, public relations and information; 2. from the point of view of functions it sizes up the last five-year plan period, emphasizing the questions of supporting professionally the supervision in Hungary, establishing the social image of librarianship, encouraging the interlibrary cooperation, the consultation concerning the profession, further on, the services, the research and research organization, the training and extension training, the standardization, the publishing activity and the international relations. FEIMER ÁGNES: Recent results in international librarianship. – The article describes *the work of IFLA performed in the seventies*. It summarizes the most important results, events and compares the new statutes, involving a great change in organizational life, with the preceding one. Beginning with the year 1972, it informs on the yearly general sessions and their results, on the work of sections and committees, on the issued publications. Finally, it deals with the role of clearing houses collecting the conference papers and describes in detail the clearing house functioning in the special library of the Centre for Library Science and Methodology. The processing of the stock is presented and an analysis on those who took part the most frequently in the conferences, given. [188–199.p.]
